<b>Context of the course</b>
<b>Summary</b>
<p>The Internship is implementation of applied activities in the field of materials views from the approach to migration.</p> <p>The aim of internship will be those activities directly related to international migration, performed by students in institutions, agencies, NGOs, foundations, corporations and other entities, and provide them with the means to exercise it on a professional level.</p> <p>This proximity will facilitate the learning of the students.
