Considering the new situation so special that have developed during the second half of the year, there has been some adjustment in the form of evaluation:

1.- The final evaluation of the subject is maintained as provided in the Teaching Guide: 60% final exam and 40% continuous evaluation.

With respect to 40% of the continuous evaluation, this percentage is maintained with respect to the final grade of the subject. Before to the process of switching to the online system, the teachers had already done some of the tests and, under the new circumstances, thanks to the tools available, the rest of this continuous evaluation has been able to be completed.

2.- In the face of the impossibility of carrying out the **final examination** in person, the tool that will be used for evaluation, through the system Moodlerooms of the University, will be **RESPONDUS**.

Its composition of two distinct parts is maintained: A test part that will be worth 40% of the exam (10 questions of a single valid answer); another of development questions with a value of

60% of the exam (with a mandatory question and two optional questions of which only one must be answered).

Duration 1.30 hours

Note: Although the weighting in the evaluation has not changed from what was agreed at the beginning of the course, the special situation in which this second semester has been developed will be taken considered.
