Evaluation: practical cases	At the beginning of each of the sessions (save for Session 1, which will be a mere introduction to the regulated sectors' ecosystem), studends will be provided with a brief practical case. Each of these practical cases (one per session) will include three specific questions/contingencies to be addressed and sorted out by students, and will be directly related to the matters discussed in the previous seions (e.g. the practical cases of Session 4 will refer to the content discussed and presented in Session 3). These practical cases will be responded by the students in writing during the first 30-45 minutes of the session, and will be jointly reviewed and discussed (together with the Professor) immediately after. The score given to each of the students for each of the practical cases (10% per practical case – there will be 7 practical cases) will depend on the students' ability to (i) to provide pragmatical, well-structured and coherent solutions; (ii) elaborate client-oriented and pro-deal responses; and (iii) show that they have understood the legal concepts discussed in previous sessions. For responding to these practical cases,	70%



laptops and all kind of materials and legislation (save for mobile phones) will be allowed and can be accessed – the practical cases imitate the situation that "regulated sector" lawyer face when they receive urgent queries from client that should be responded in a very short timeframes.
