<p>The student will have to make a personal and unpublished final work about any of the subjects and dimensions of international development cooperation, under the supervision of an expert personal tutor in the subject of the student's choice.</p> <p>In this Master, given its eminently professional orientation, two types or two profiles are prioritized final course research.</p> <p>1. Firstly, we opt for a type of research focused on the design, elaboration and justification of programs and projects of international cooperation for development. In this case the student, under the supervision of an expert tutor in the field, must present a cooperation project or program on a subject or dimension of special relevance within the field of cooperation. It is, therefore, a research work that, including elements of theoretical reflection on the issue being studied, is, above all, an applied research, focused on the design and development of practical and applicable instruments.</p> <p>Secondly, from the Master's degree onwards, the student chooses a type of research centered on the study of cases or concrete realities, with the aim of detecting both needs and social specificities, economic, political and cultural issues that should be taken into account when designing and carrying out a cooperation project in the chosen study area.</p>
