Additional interest is given to the recent tendencies of protectionist national economic policies and how they affect the international trading system.

Related to Tema 6: Antidumping / Trade in Services Case Study (15%) – Students in three working groups are free to choose one services' sector each group, relevant in international trade and analyse main trading partners and world trade tendencies (e.g. transport, travel, other business services, financial services, telecommunications). It is recommended to include TPP and TIIP aspects.	The case study is an exercise to project international trade tendencies of a given services' sector using among others statistical data and public policy analysis (group work, written and oral exercise – mini-research and preparation of power point slides out of class and oral presentation in class). The written part of the assessment is a pp presentation.	15%
