<p><b>Speaking Skills (25%, cannot be retaken)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Compulsory attendance is required when preparing the presentation/video project in class. If any student fails attendance on any of these days, he/ she will only be able to get the minimum standards (5).</li> <li>- Writing notes are not allowed when speaking skills are assessed.</li> </ul> <p>• <b>Presentation</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The presentation will be in pairs but if a member fails to show up on the presentation date, the other member will have to present the topic individually to be assessed.</li> <li>- Notes are not allowed in presentations.</li> <li>- If a student has memorized the presentation and is not able to answer the questions about it, s/he will not be able to get the minimum standards.</li> <li>- The presentation in pairs must take 4 minutes sharing out the time given (2 minutes each).
