Moreover, this subject will help future graduates achieve a good communicative competence in English language and be able to know and apply the appropriate methodological tools and strategies for teaching English in Early Childhood Education. The contents of the subject will provide the student with knowledge to use English in the classroom. English for Education I is a compulsory subject in the degree of Foreign Language Teaching (English) in the Degree of Early Childhood Education.

- The video recording link must be submitted the date of the final exam. If not, the group will be penalized (-1).
